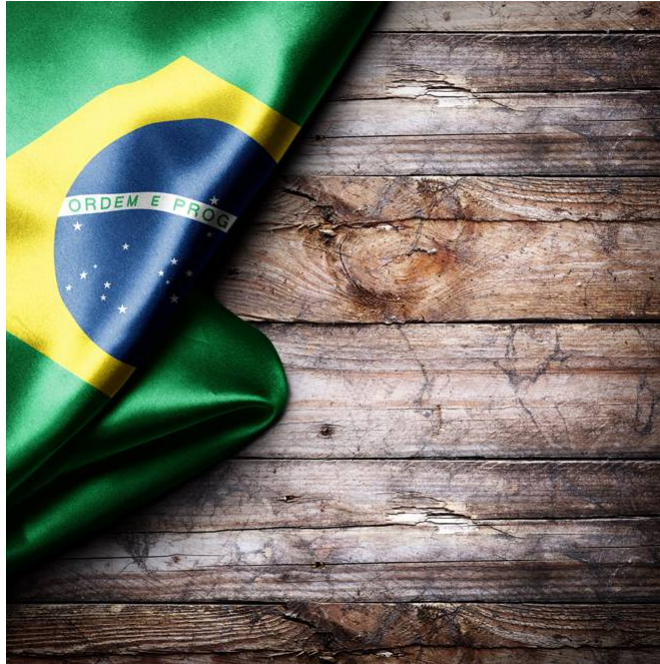




### **Doing Business in Brazil?**

Brazilian regulations are among the most stringent in the world, let PCI Assist in maintaining your compliance. Brazilian Port Authorities now require all shippers to provide a declaration of all wooden packing for cargo to be loaded, discharged or trans-shipped in Brazil.



### **Know Your Wood**

The most common types of wood which require declaration are:

Boxes, crates, cages, cable drums, spools or reels.

Pallets, platforms, packing cases, wedges, or shores.

### **How to Comply**

Contact PCI Logistics for shipments to or from Brazil so we can guide you through the four classifications of declaration. Failure to furnish proper declaration and stamped wood will result in cargo being refused and returned to origin.

### **WPM Classifications**

Wooden Package: N/A (no wood in shipment)

Wooden Package: Processed

Wooden Package: Treated / Certified

Wooden Package: Not Treated / Not Certified



Regardless of which Wooden Package Material (WPM) status is declared  
an IPPC stamp indicating wood has been treated is necessary.
